- This is in continuation to Council's circular dt.6.1.2022, a copy of which is enclosed as Annexure-A for ready reference and is self explanatory.
- The PCI portal will open between 28.3.2022 to 1.4.2022 for existing institutions applying for
 - i) Continuation of approval
 - ii) Introduction of new course
 - iii) Raise in admission
 - iv) Services details of prescribed documents to be submitted in service portal for following categories of services are enclosed as Annexure-B.
 - a) Change in the name of institution / Trust
 - b) Change of address / location of institution
 - c) Change of Examining Authority
 - d) Change of hospital
 - e) Closure of course
 - f) Closure of institution

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- 3. The dates for opening of PCI Portal for New Institutions which are covered under exemption to moratorium, S.No. a) b) & c) of Council's circular dt.9.9.2019 will be announced separately. The Council's said circular dt.9.9.2019 under reference is already available on Council's website www.pci.nic.in Institutions are advised to keep visiting the Council's website in this regard.
- 4. During approval process for the academic year 2022-2023 for <u>introduction of new pharmacy course(s) by existing institutions</u>, the institution will have to apply on the portal along with requisite Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges (non-refundable) along with GST and submit the below mentioned documents mandatorily at the time of application for consideration of the application
 - i) For B.Pharm course

a) Consent of affiliation of Examining Authorityb) NOC of the State Government

In case, the State Government has done away with the issuance of NOC of the State Government for starting of pharmacy course, in that case institution shall upload the said communication from the State Government as a documentary evidence.

 For D.Pharm / Pharm.D & Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) / new M.Pharm course and introduction of new M.Pharm specialization / B.Pharm (Practice) course

a) Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority

b) MOU with 300 bedded hospital (applicable for Pharm.D course) in the prescribed format, a copy of which is enclosed as Annexure-C.

5. Please note that -

- i) the above documents should be in English duly signed by the Principal and legible.
- ii) in case the above documents are not submitted, the proposal for introduction of new course will not be entertained by the Council and will be summarily rejected.
- iii) The procedure of submission of affidavit by existing institutions in lieu of submission of mandatory documents has been done away with and will no longer be accepted.

6. For raise in admissions

i) Please note that number of admissions are restricted as per following details -

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- ii) For consideration of raise in admissions wherever applicable, the institution shall apply for the same as per the provisions of the Regulations for consideration of the council, however the admissions for the raise which is being sought shall be done only after the approval of the PCI and the examining authority.
- iii) It will be the responsibility of the institution to obtain the consent of Examining Authority for raise in admission before making admission and submit to PCI.
- iv) In case, the institution fails to obtain and submit the consent of the Examining Authority for raise in admission, it shall not admit the students (for raise) failing which the consequences shall rest on the institution. The PCI in no way shall be responsible for the same.

7. For Services

Similarly the institutions applying for Services shall also mandatorily submit the statutory documents as prescribed in Annexure-B failing which application for services will be summarily rejected. Service charges are non-refundable.

8. Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges

For the payment of the Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges multiple payment gateways are available and include payments through BillDesk, (NEFT/RTGS) and SBI. (non-refundable)

9. <u>GST</u>

Applicable GST on Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges has to be paid. (non-refundable)

10. Cautions

The following cautions shall be noted and exercised while submitting online application on PCI portal for consideration of approval for academic session 2022-2023.

 The Last date for completing the application process on PCI portal will not be extended under any circumstances and hence institutions are required to apply online in SIF without fail within the available window from 28.3.2022 to 1.4.2022.

The institutions are advised not to wait for the last date for submission of SIF as overcrowding may pose technical problems. The Council will not be responsible in case institution is not able to apply on time. It is reiterated that the last date will not be extended and no further time will be granted to complete the application process.

- ii) All Institutions that are already approved by the PCI for conduct of course / approved under section 12 for registration as a pharmacist for the D.Pharm / B.Pharm / M.Pharm / Pharm.D, Pharm.D (PB) / B.Pharm (Practice) programs have to mandatorily apply on the PCI portal, submitting all the requisite information and Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges for consideration of approval.
- iii) Institutions already having approval for 2022-2023 or beyond 2022-2023 academic session shall also mandatorily apply in SIF and pay the mandatory Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges for retention of already granted approval.
- iv) Applying for approval is entirely the responsibility of the institution and failure to apply will result in not being reflected in the approved list of Institutions on the Council's website leading to "No Admission Year".

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- v) All fields in the SIF are to be mandatorily completed including -
 - a) teaching staff details (Name, qualification, specialization at PG level (very important), Years of experience etc).
 - b) details of salary paid to teaching staff during the period of January 2021 to November, 2021.
 - c) the staff names that are reflected in an institution, as per the PCI circular dt.9.10.2013, a copy of which is enclosed as **Annexure-D** will be not counted for the number of staff for the particular program if they have left the institution to join another institution in the same academic year.
 - d) the staff whose name is reflected in an institution presently for the academic year 2022-23 will not be given credit in another institution for the year 2022-23 even if they join another institution during the said period. Such information should be clearly informed by the faculty to the joining institution and the PCI. If any information is suppressed, the individual faculty will be responsible and can be debarred from teaching assignments for a period up to 3 years under statutory provisions of "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014".
 - e) the appointment of qualified principal and teaching staff as per the statutory provisions of various Education Regulations is mandatory and if any noncompliance is observed, the approval will not be granted.
 - f) the appointment of deficient staff will not be considered as a compliance during the appeal period.

11. Please note that -

- i) if the details are found missing (not filled) / incorrect / false / non-compliance of the prescribed statutory provisions is observed, the application will not be processed for approval leading to "No Admission Year" for the institution and the Principal may also be debarred from holding any administrative position in future.
- the PCI will not be responsible for the above consequences and hence due caution be exercised while filling the SIF and submission to PCI.
- iii) submission of above-mentioned statutory documents is a pre-requisite mandatory requirement.
- iv) in the absence of submission of pre-requisite mandatory documents as detailed above, application will be rejected for introduction of new course, raise in admission and services.
- v) merely submission of application does not mean / ensure approval for -
 - extension of approval.
 - raise in admissions.
 - introduction of new course(s).
- vi) Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges and GST is non-refundable.

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12. It is also clarified that no hard copy of the application in SIF will be accepted. The institutions have to apply online only on PCI portal.

13. Important

- It is the responsibility of the institution to comply with the prescribed norms with regard to teaching faculty and infrastructure etc. as prescribed under the statutory provisions of the various Education Regulations for already existing courses, failing which their application will not be considered by the PCI for -
 - · extension of approval.
 - · raise in admission.
 - · introduction of new course(s).
- Please also find enclosed herewith details of staff requirement for various pharmacy courses running simultaneously by an institution for your information and strict compliance. (Annexure-E)
- iii) While submitting the online SIF, the institutions are also required to submit duly notarized affidavit on 100 rupees stamp paper with regard to payment of salary to the teaching staff. The said prescribed format of the affidavit is enclosed as Annexure-F for your ready reference and strict compliance.

In view of above institutions are requested apply online with in prescribed deadline with late fee of Ra. 1.00 lakh per institutions.

Sir/Madam

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The portal for existing institutions has been closed on 5.1.2022. Since some institutions failed to apply online, the matter was considered by 357th Executive Committee (3rd &5th January, 2022) of the PCI which decided as under :

- A. Introduction of late fee in respect of institutions which have failed to apply on PCI portal during approval process 2022-2023.
- not to extend the last date beyond 5.1.2022 for existing institutions to submit SIF.
- b) in case institutions have still failed to apply within the prescribed deadline of 5.1.2022, Council may give another opportunity by introducing late fee of Rs.1 lakh per institution to submit SIF.
- c) for this a portal may be opened again giving 5 days time.

Forgotten the user ID and password,

- a) institutions be asked to submit duly notarized affidavit on 100 rupees court paper-
- giving reason for not having the user ID and password already issued by the PCI.
- bear the responsibility that in the event of any dispute with regard to ownership of the institution etc. the management will be squarely responsible for the consequences and PCI will not be responsible for it. The said affidavit be signed by the Chairman of the management of the trust. A copy of prescribed affidavit is enclosed as Annexure-1.
- b) the institution shall submit the affidavit through e-mail to PCI office including the hard copy.

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c) the said institutions may apply under the "late fee category" by paying prescribed late fee.

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C. In the light of above decisions, it may be noted that :

- a) opportunity is extended to existing institutions to apply online on PCl portal with late fees of Rs.1 Lakh per institution.
- b) institutions which have forgotten the user ID & password are required to submit the duly notarized affidavit on 100 rupees court paper in the enclosed prescribed format so as to reach the Council's office on or before 12.1.2022 by 6.00 pm positively. Please note that
 - affidavit submitted after 12.1.2022 (6.00 pm) will not be entertained by the PCI.
 - incomplete affidavit or affidavit which is not in prescribed format will be summarily rejected and filed.
 - iii) failure to submit complete prescribed affidavit within due date will lead to non opening of the portal for such institutions and consequences thereof shall rest on the institution and the PCI in no way will be responsible for it.

With reference to the subject cited above. I am directed to inform that subject cited iasue was considered by 93/CC in its meeting held in July. 2013 which noted that in some cases teaching faculty either resign onlare terminated during the academic session which adversely effects the quality of education.

In view of above, it was decided to instruct the pharmacy institutions that -

a) the teaching faculty whose name is shown at the time of inspection and approval is granted by the PCI on the besis of availability of the said teaching staff will not be eligible to join other institutions during the same academic year. Hence staff who have resigned or terminated by the management on grounds other than the criminal miseondost during the currency of the said academic session will not be taken to count while granting approval for such institutions.

b) in the event of any dispute the matter shall be referred to the PCL

The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pham.) Course Regulations, 2014

No. 14-154/ 2010- PCL—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 and 18 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (8 of 1948), the Pharmacy Council of India, with the approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations; namely-

CHAPTER-I

1. Short title and commencement -

(1) These regulations may be called the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

 B. Pharm shall consist of a certificate, having passed the course of study and examination as prescribed in these regulations, for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist to practice the profession under the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

CHAPTER-II

3. Duration of the course. -

B. Pharm: The duration of the course shall be four academic years (annual/semester) full time with each academic year spread over a period of not less than two hundred working days for annual pattern and hundred working days for each semester.

- 4. Minimum qualification for admission to -
- A. First year B. Pharm A pass in any of the following examinations
 - i. Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology as optional subjects individually. "However, the students possessing 10+2 qualification from non-formal and non-class rooms based schooling such as National Institute of Open Schooling, open school systems of States etc. shall not be eligible for admission to B.Pharm Course."
 - Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

Provided that a student should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the course.

Provided that there shall be reservation of seats for the students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government/State Government/Union Territory Administration as the case may be from time to time.

B. B. Pharm lateral entry (to second year/third semester) -

A pass in D. Pharm course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

- Number of admissions in B. Pharm course shall be as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
- Course of study. The course of study for B. Pharm shall include the subjects, number of hours in a week devoted to each subject for its teaching in theory, practical and tutorial as may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
- Practical Training: The student is required to undergo practical training of 150 hrs either in (A) Pharmacy Practice (Hospital/Community pharmacy) or (B) Pharmaceutical and allied Industries spread over a period of not less than one month during the course of study after second year.
- Syllabus. The syllabus for each subject of study shall be as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
- 9. Approval of the authority conducting the course of study. -
 - No person, institution, society, trust or university shall start and conduct B. Pharm programme without the prior approval of the Pharmacy Council of India.

- Any person or pharmacy college for the purpose of obtaining permission under sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, shall submit a scheme as may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India.
- The scheme referred to in sub-regulation (2) above, shall be in such form and contain such particulars and be preferred in such manner and be accompanied with such fee as may be prescribed:

Provided that the Pharmacy Council of India shall not approve any institution under these regulations unless it provides adequate arrangements for teaching in regard to building, accommodation, labs., equipments, teaching staff, non-teaching staff, etc., as specified in Appendix-A to these regulations.

- 10. Examination. -
 - 1. There shall be an examination at the end of each academic year/semester of B.Pharm.
 - 2. Each examination may be held twice every year namely regular and supplementary examination.
 - The examinations shall be of written and practical (including oral nature) carrying maximum marks for each part as may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.

11. Eligibility for appearing Examination.— Only such students who produce certificate from the Head of the Institution in which he or she has undergone the course of study by attending not less than 80% of the classes held both in theory and practicals separately in each subject shall be eligible for appearing at examination.

12. Mode of examinations.-

- (1) Theory examination shall be of three hours and practical examination shall be of four hours duration.
- (2) A candidate who fails in theory or practical examination of a subject shall re-appear in theory or practical as the case may be,
- (3) Practical examination shall also consist of a viva-voce (Oral) examination.

13. Award of sessional marks and maintenance of records-

- (1) A regular record of both theory and practical class work and examinations conducted in an institution imparting training for B. Pharm course, shall be maintained for each student in the institution and 25 marks for each theory and 25 marks for each practical subject shall be allotted as sessional marks.
- (2) There shall be at least three periodic sessional examinations during each academic year and the highest aggregate of any two performances shall form the basis of calculating sessional marks.
 - (3) The sessional marks in practicals shall be allotted on the following basis:-
 - Actual performance in the sessional examination (15 marks);
 - (ii) Day to day assessment in the practical class work, promptness, viva-voce, record maintenance, etc. (10 marks).
- 14. Minimum marks for passing examination.— A student shall not be declared to have passed examination unless he or she secures at least 50% marks in each of the subjects separately in the theory and practical examinations, including sessional marks. The students securing 60% marks or above in aggregate in all subjects in a single attempt at B. Pharm shall be declared to have passed in the First Class. Students securing 75% marks or above in any subject or subjects shall be declared to have passed with distinction in the subject or those subjects provided he/she passes in all the subjects in a single attempt.
- 14 (a). Eligibility for the promotion to the next year. All the students who have appeared for all the subjects and passed the First year Annual Examination are Eligible for promotion to the second year and so on. However, failure in more than two subjects shall debar him /her from promotion to the next year classes.
- 15. Approval of examinations.— Examinations mentioned in regulations 10 to12 and 14 shall be held by the examining authority which shall be approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948. Such approval shall be granted only if the examining authority concerned fulfills the conditions as specified in Appendix–(B) to these regulations.
- Certificate of passing examination.— Every student who has passed the examinations for the B. Pharm shall be granted a certificate by the examining authority.

APPENDIX- (A)

(See regulation 9)

CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY THE ACADEMIC TRAINING INSTITUTION

- Any authority or institution in India applying to the Pharmacy Council of India for approval of courses of study for B. Pharm. under sub-section (1) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 shall comply with the infrastructural facilities as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.
- B. Pharm. programmes shall be conducted only in those institutions which are approved by the Pharmacy Council of India for B.Pharm course as provided under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948;

In addition to the laboratories, balance room, aseptic room or cabinet, animal house and a machine room shall also be provided.

Floor area of the laboratory should not be less than 30 square feet per student required to work in the laboratory at any given time subject to a minimum of 900 square feet including Preparation Room.

Laboratories should be fitted and constructed in a manner that these can be kept reasonably clean. Gas and water fittings, shelves, furning cupboards be provided wherever necessary.

6. EQUIPMENT AND APPARATUS :

The details of equipments and apparatus required for various departments shall be as prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India from time to time.

APPENDIX - B (See regulation 15) CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BY THE EXAMINING AUTHORITY

- The Examining Authority shall be a Indian University constituted by the Central Government/State Government/Union Territory Administration or a Deemed to be University. It shall ensure that discipline and decorum of the examinations are strictly observed at the examination centers.
- 2. It shall permit the Inspector or Inspectors of the Pharmacy Council of India to visit and inspect the examinations.
- 3. It shall provide:-
 - (a) adequate rooms with necessary furniture for holding written examinations;
 - (b) well-equipped laboratories for holding practical examinations;
 - (c) an adequate number of qualified and responsible examiners and staff to conduct and invigilate the examinations; and
 - (d) such other facilities as may be necessary for efficient and proper conduct of examinations.
- It shall, if so required by a candidate, furnish the statement of marks secured by a candidate in the examinations after payment of prescribed fee, if any, to the Examining Authority.
- It shall appoint examiners whose qualifications should be similar to those of the teachers in the respective subjects as prescribed in the Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
- 6. In pursuance of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948, the Examining Authority shall communicate to the Secretary, Pharmacy Council of India, not less than six weeks in advance the dates fixed for examinations, the time-table for such examinations, so as to enable the Council to arrange for inspection teams to attend at such examinations.
- The Examining Authority shall ensure that examiners for conducting examination for B. Pharm. programme shall be persons possessing pharmacy qualification and are actually involved in the teaching of the B. Pharm. programme in an approved institution.
